


# CONTENTdm enhancements over the last year

- *Our feature focus for the last year has been on improving the scalability and robustness of CONTENTdm as well as improving the end-user display of content.*
  - Usage statistics that integrate better with Google Analytics (May 2013)
  - Improved SEO and accessibility support (Nov 2013, more in Mar 2014)
  - Significant work fixing bugs reported (~20% of our development effort)
  - FIND Farm for Hosted customers greatly improves our ability to scale. (Jan 2014)
  - Performance improvements continue (caching improvements released Mar 2014)
  - Video player update (Mar 2014)
  - Automated sitemap generation (Mar 2014; production rollout now!)


# CONTENTdm 6.8 Features and Fixes

- **Website Config Tool** improvements
  - Session based preview and “stock config” modes
  - Improved File Management for doing customization work
  - Added ability to load a custom favicon 
  - Added 2 new levels of image download sizes
  - Changed UI to locate “action” buttons even in scrolling pages
- **Improved automated sitemap generation** for SEO and OAI speed improvements.
- Began production cut-over to **new web service for serving of PDF files** (users should notice no change at all, but this change allows scaling up)
- 19 other priority backlog issues fixed.

# CONTENTdm “quick start” expansion

- CONTENTdm “quick start” includes:
  - The CONTENTdm software hosted by OCLC
  - Three Project Clients for building digital collections
  - 10GB of storage for up to 3,000 digital items
  - Access to documentation, training and office hours
- 400+ libraries worldwide currently use “quick start”

## OCLC releases WorldCat Works as linked data



**DUBLIN, Ohio, 28 April 2014**—OCLC has made 197 million bibliographic work descriptions—WorldCat Works—available as linked data, a format native to the Web that will improve discovery of library collections through a variety of popular sites and Web services.

Release of this data marks another step toward providing interconnected linked data views of WorldCat. By making this linked data available, library collections can be exposed to the wider Web community, integrating these collections and making them more easily discoverable through websites and services that library users visit daily, such as Google, Wikipedia and social networks.

"Bibliographic data stored in traditional record formats has reached its limits of efficiency and utility," said Richard Wallis, OCLC Technology Evangelist. "New technologies, influenced by the Web, now enable us to move toward managing WorldCat data as entities—such as 'Works,' 'People,' 'Places' and more—as part of the global web of data."



## Using WorldCat to create linked data for your digital item records

## SHARE: Use the Digital Collection Gateway; take advantage of WorldCat and its syndicates



- Start by Sharing of CONTENTdm with WorldCat.org, and sync back the OCLC #s
- You interact with WorldCat via the Gateway
  - Customize the WorldCat.org display to best meet end user needs
  - Schedule your harvests as appropriate for your collection's growth
